Truth and Reconciliation-Video Project

The VSB has undertaken a special project under the theme of reconciliation as part of our ongoing commitment to implementing the recommendations of the Truth and Reconciliation Commission. Currently the themes of reconciliation are being explored in two ways: raising of a Reconciliation Pole at the VSB School Board Office and a documentary video on what reconciliation means.

Our students have an opportunity to participate in the video project, under the direction of Suzi Bekkattla, our Indigenous Enhancement Worker. As a school we can celebrate Indigenous education by interviewing elders, and elders can help by explaining how oral tradition was important. We are hoping by interviewing elders and witnessing carving, our students will learn more about ancient traditions. We are confident this will also be a healing process through art while bringing alive the impact of residential schools on Indigenous peoples across BC. This process is an important one for all Canadians of any ancestry.
