Motion: To approve the five iPads, Boardmaker license, and Technology Fund for a total of \$3800. M/S/C


## b. Vice Principal – Elyssa

The staff has been working to create a key addition to the code of conduct that is based on First People's Principals. A Circle of Courage is divided into four sections with each section being represented by an animal with specific qualities. This will be used to guide the students' social and emotional growth.
