- ✓ Enter in your first name, last name, email and create a password.
- ✓ Select a security question.
- ✓ Check YES to receive email notifications



A registration confirmation email will be forwarded to you. Click on the link provided inside the email to confirm your email and School Cash Online account (check spam).

The confirmation link will open the School Cash Online site, prompting you to sign into your account. Use your email address and password to log in.



This step will connect your child to your account.

- a) Enter the School Board Name
- b) Enter the School Name.
- c) Enter Your Child's First Name, Last Name and Date of Birth.
- d) Select Continue.
- e) On the next page confirm that you are related to the child, check in the Agree box and select Continue.
- f) Your child has been added to your account.

School Fees & Forms

This year, the school is collecting \$35 per student for school supplies, plus \$35 per student for an activity fee (EarthBites), and \$10 per student for student agenda (where applicable). Fee's are payable online at wsb.schoolcashonline.com. Please follow the instructions on the left if you require to set up an account.

If families are facing any financial hardship and cannot pay the school fees, please communicate this with M Belanger or Ms.

MacFadden. Our school PAC and communities work together to ensure all students have access to the essential materials and programming throughout the year. All communication will be strictly confidential and names will never be shared under any circumstances.
