- Create a basic BCeID account and check yourself anytime!
- Log on to access your full educational record (i.e. check what you have completed, order your own transcripts for post-secondary, check your marks, etc.)

Transcripts– BCeID

You need to create a BCeID account so Post-Secondary institutions can have access to your Ministry Transcript via internet communication during admission process. Once registered:

1. Click on “Service Directory”
2. Fill in the following search fields:
 1. Type of BCeID: Basic
 2. Who provides the service: Education
3. Subscribe to the following services:
 1. Personal Education Number (PEN)
 2. Student Transcripts (STSPRD)
4. Once you are subscribed you can check off the post-secondary institutions you are applying to, and transcripts will automatically be sent halfway through and end of year. *Do not check off the "send immediately" option.*


POST-SECONDARY INFORMATION SESSIONS

Go to the **SOURCE** (Hint: “Undergraduate Admissions Advisor”)




Any questions for specific universities should be sent to their representative contacts

Which Types of Scholarships Can I Apply For?

1. External Scholarships & Bursaries

- Awarded by various organizations and institutions throughout the school year
- In most cases, you are applying directly to the organization
- For those scholarships which require a school nomination, submit the required application package to seek nomination from the Gladstone Scholarship Committee 2 weeks prior to the deadline
- Types includes:
 - Post-Secondary Institutions
 - Corporate Institutions
 - Parent/Guardian Workplace

Which Types of Scholarships Can I Apply For?

2. Internal School Scholarships & Bursaries

- Awarded by donors to the school
- Gladstone Scholarship Application Package – information TBA on Teams
- Based on specific criteria, typically in the following categories:
 - Academic Achievement
 - Athletics
 - Community Service
 - Financial Need
 - Overcoming Adversity
 - Specific Subject Area (e.g. Performing Arts)

Which Types of Scholarships Can I Apply For?

3. District Scholarships

- Awarded by the BC Ministry of Education and the Vancouver School Board
- Gladstone Scholarship Application Package-information TBA on Teams
- Based on interest in specific subject areas:
 - Applied Design, Skills, and Technology: Business Education, Home Economics, & Technology Education
 - Languages: French & Spanish
 - Performing & Visual Arts: Drama, Fine Arts, & Music
 - Physical & Health Education
