PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

Collingwood Neighbourhood Annex was built in 2002 to serve the new Collingwood Village community. The development of this site was done in partnership with the City of Vancouver.

The design of the school features has an internal connection to the Collingwood Neighbourhood House to enable the sharing of some facilities between the Neighbourhood House and the school.

The school is a two storey structure and parking is located underground to maximize open space.
